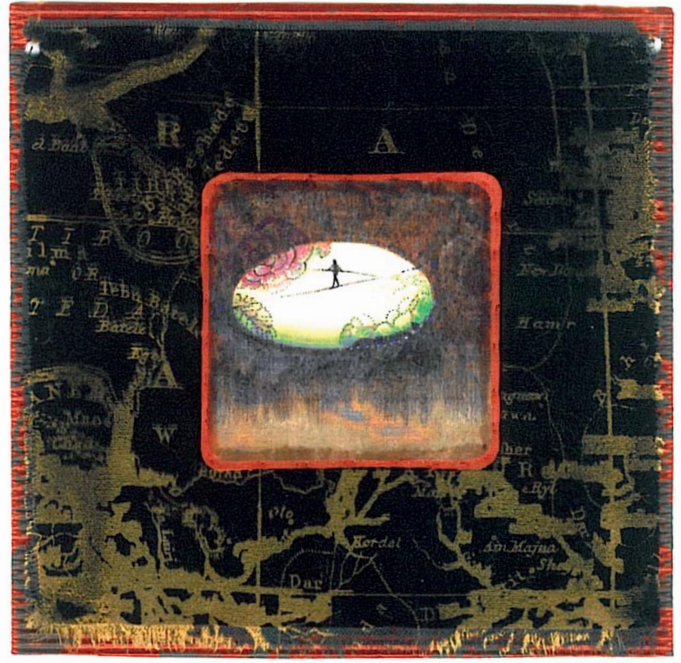


International Baltic Mini Textile Triennial Gdynia (Poland)
